Choir Member – Adult

Overview:

The Choir's role has great importance in the Parish's Liturgy. Choir members share in the proper performance of the music sung, and encourage the active participation of the faithful in the singing.

Activities/Responsibilities

- Under the direction of the Choir Director, members integrate their own area of responsibility in the singing of liturgical music.
- May be called upon to sing solo performances or play an instrument.
- Attends weekly practices and regular rehearsals, comes with music prepared.
- Is available to sing during special Church services and events as required.
- Works in conjunction with other members of the music ministry to share in providing music for the Liturgy.

Skills, Experience and Personal Qualities

- Is an active participant in parish worship and has an understanding and love for liturgical music.
- Demonstrates adequate skill in vocal techniques. Musical training is an asset.
- Needs to be a person who relates well with other choir members and the director.
- Is able to comfortably and confidently sing in public and willing to develop vocal skills.
- Has enthusiasm, a positive attitude and a genuine appreciation of music.
- Maintains confidentiality appropriate to this ministry.
