Overview

The Choir's role has great importance in Parish Liturgy. Choir members share in the proper performance of music sung, and encourage the active participation of the faithful in the singing.

Activities/Responsibilities

- Under the direction of the Choir Director.
- A child/youth shares his/her gift of music and love of singing with others.
- May be called upon to sing solo performances/ play an instrument during the Liturgy.
- Attends regular practices and comes prepared for liturgy.
- Is available to sing during special Church services and events as required.

Skills, Experience and Personal Qualities

- Active participant in Parish worship.
- Shows adequate skill and is able to comfortably and confidently sing in public.
- Musical training is an asset, not a necessity.
- Desires to serve the community and to commit time and talents to this ministry.
- Is able to cooperate with others in the choir and with the director.
- Has enthusiasm, positive attitude and a genuine appreciation of music.
